It starts its journey by prevention of HIV/AIDS among 24 urban slums of Coimbatore District, supported by APAC USAIDS in the year 1998. With this experience, Imayam implements HIV/AIDS related program in Coimbatore Central Prison, school students with support from UNICEF, Industrial workers through TNSACS Chennai, Care and support program with PWDS Alliance / DFID.

Now, Imayam is a good resource person in the HIV/AIDS field and invited by many schools and Colleges, Companies and Police recruitment Agencies. Imayam has got good support and strong network covering 580 PLHA families with nutrition's support through CSI Church every month. The community is giving good recognition to suzlon foundation. The VDC Members are very co-operative and shows interest in community sustainability. In all Eye camp programmes follow-up cases are taken complete treatment.



The identified and interested HRG are referred to various rehabilitation services. 10 HRG have gotten support from Coimbatore police commissioner to do tiffin center, auto rickshaw and tailoring machine for their livelihood. Imayam has helped many HRGs to avail social benefits like PATTa, driving license and identity card from the government.



Celan and Green Project - ACC

In Collaboration with ACC in Madukkarai, we support the „Clean and Green“ Project, initiated by ACC in 2018. The people involved help keep the villages clean and handle the collected waste correctly.

Throughout the year we have helped the project through conducting actives such as an „Eye Camp“ for the Green friends as well as Awareness programs such as door to door. In February 2019 a total of 354 households were educated about the importance of wet waste and dry waste, through door to door visit by green friends along with project staff team.

Throughout the program, people have been educated about Geocycle activities, where in all plastic on waste materials will be used on fire for cement iron except clean and metal items.

We also host „Exposure Visits“ in which students from Govt. Hr. Secondary School, Madukarai visit the resource Park and in which the Project activities are explained to them.



The following activities are carried out during 2018 - 2019, under clean and green project Madukarai by Iyamam.

In this project, 43 green friends were involved to collect wet waste and dry waste from 8500 households. During the year of 2018 - 2019 -kg of wet waste collected from individual household and converted as a manure in the resource center. This manure will be used for gardening and to farmer field - Number of dry waste is collected and given to Geocycle or recycling. The Green friends are covered with insurance and uniforms.

Microcredit Program

Imayam has 540 women SHG functioning in rural, corporation and urban areas of coimbatore district. The active and eligible SHG are linked with ICCI Bank to start various micro enterprises.

Women Empowerment Project

In collaboration with ACC, Imayam has conducted training on tailoring and embroidery to the women. In this training, 160 women have completed training and received a certificates. Few of them are self-entrepreneurs and a majority of the women are placed in various jobs.

Participation in ICC Complaints Committee

Imayam is working as a ICC member in 19 mills in Coimbatore District. Every month, sexual harassment meeting will be conducted for the adolescent girls who are working in the mill about "good touch" and "bad touch." This program is conducting under the

prevention of sexual harassment act 2013. Sexual harassment incidents will be solved through counseling service.



Member Participation in Child Welfare Committee

Secretary is a member in Child Welfare Committee. This Committee consists of five persons, including Chairman. This office is functioning at Don Basco Campus. Every day this committee will gather where in the child related issues will be taken care of.

The inmates are enrolled and referred from various departments like police station, women help line, NGO, district administration and local CBOs. In the Swedhar Greh Home there is a qualified

counselor who gives counseling to problematic women. The inmates get free accommodation and food. They will be provided skill training and rehabilitation services to them.

National Rajiv Ghandi creche

Imayam owns 11 crèche in which children. It is a facility which enables parents to leave their children while they are at work. These day-care facilities host kids from 6 months of age up to 6 years. It's objective is to improve the nutrition and health status of children as well as to promote physical, cognitive, social and emotional development. Through this scheme, 275 children are benefitting.



Nutrition supplement

Imayam has enrolled 680 PLHA with their families. The majority of them are under ART Treatment. Imayam is supporting to provide nutritious food every month by mobilizing the resources from CSI Church. Besides, Imayam mobilizes resources and hands these out during Dibawili and Christmas festival by giving new dresses to the children.

Partnership with MSI-TN for sexual Harassment Programmes

Imayam has got programs through SAVE NGO Thirppur to implement sexual harassment meetings in textile units in Coimbatore District. Under this program, ten mills are selected where sexual awareness meeting with HR Personell, workers, middle level managers, ICC Capacity Building Trainings will be organized. The team of staff trained as TOT trainers for this program.
